TIAA-CREF Lifecycle 2030 Fund (TCRIX)

INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The investment seeks high total return through capital appreciation and income. The fund invests in underlying funds according to an asset allocation strategy designed for investors planning to retire in or within a few years of 2030. It expects to allocate approximately 83.60% of assets to equity underlying funds and 16.40% of assets to fixed-income underlying funds.

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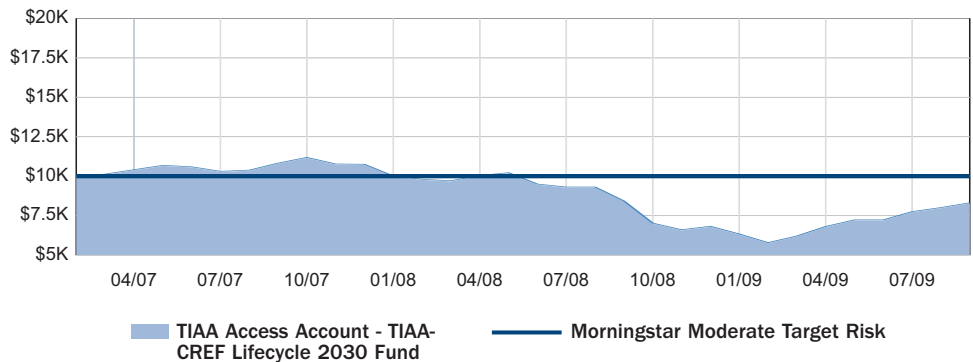

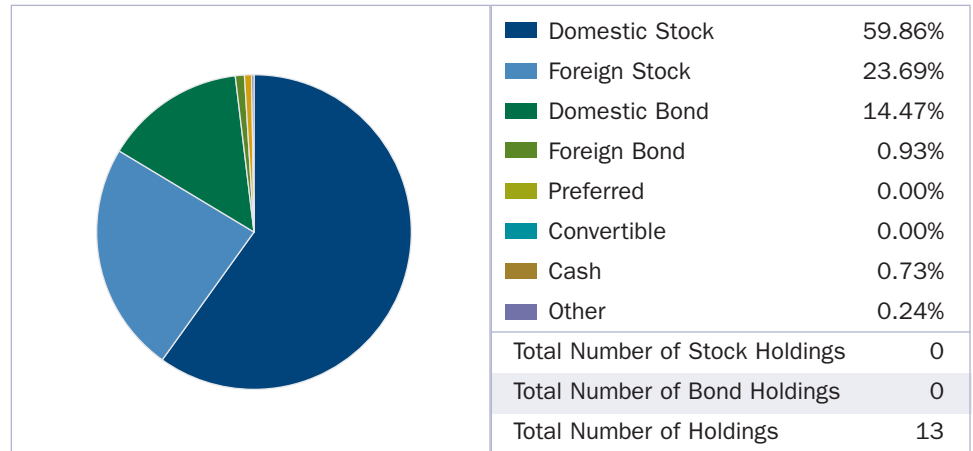

The chart illustrates the performance of a hypothetical \$10,000 investment made in the account on the month-end after the commencement of operations.
